Members Welfare Association (MWA) [E.g. a member who has joined on or before March 31st, 2019 is automatically eligible for the benefits from April 01st, 2024 and so on]
- 2. In Joint shareholding, Primary holder member is ELIGIBLE.
- 3. Member must be a Primary holder in savings bank account at any of the SVC Bank's branch.

### \*Terms & Conditions

- 1. **Medical expenses:** A member shall apply not more than once in THREE months. Cost of non-prescribed medicines/OTC (Over the counter medicines like aspirin, paracetamol, pain balms, etc.) shall not be reimbursed. Vitamins, tonics will be considered only if prescribed with full mention of the nature of ailment. [General weakness will not be considered as an ailment]
- 2. Original receipts/ cash-memos shall be submitted with the claim.
- 3. Each claim shall have to be accompanied by a photocopy of Doctor's relevant prescription which shall mention ailment being treated. These prescription copies and original receipts/ cash memos shall not be returned
- 4. Reimbursements are done exclusively as per the rules, regulations and policies of MWA.
- 5. The reimbursement of expenses shall be applied for within THREE months after the event, i.e. financial conditions, age & after discharge / cure in the case of illness.
- 6. Member have to submit Declaration stating Annual income along with latest filed Income Tax Returns (ITR).
- 7. Invoices settled in Third Party Insurance/Mediclaim will not be considered.
- 8. In case there is shortfall, or in deserving cases, President shall have powers to reimburse over and above eligible amount, based on recommendation of the trustees.
- 9. For reimbursement over and above eligible amount, other factors such as age, financial condition, number of members in family etc. will be taken into consideration.
